Boat Captains are required to attend a mandatory meeting on Sunday, July 2nd at 1:00 pm at the Lake Blue Ridge Marina. Judging numbers will be distributed at this meeting.

Rules:

- Boats should attempt to stay approximately 100 feet apart and follow in the trail of the boat immediately in front of them.
- Minimum wake speed to be maintained and no passing will be allowed (NO BOW RISE)
Follow in the direction of the marshalling boat.
- No Open Flames
- No Fireworks
- Arrive with a full tank of Fuel
